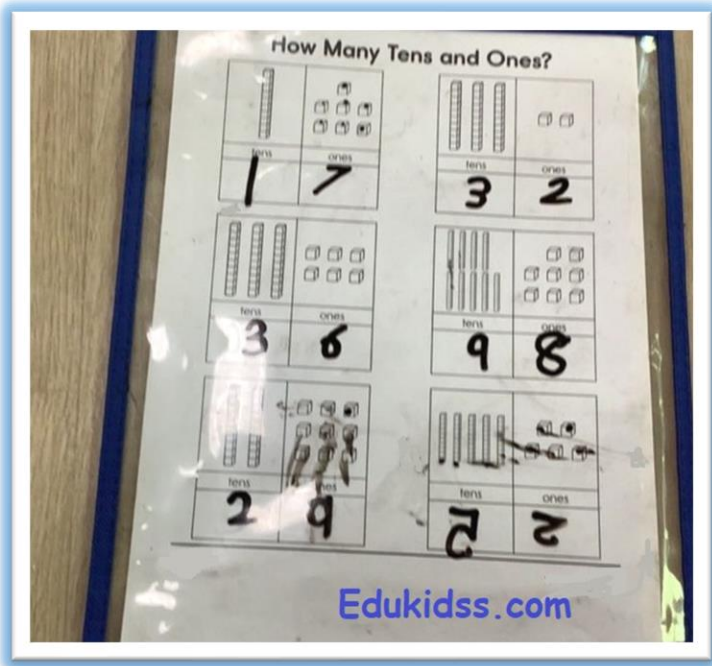







Dad is sad. Dad did not fit in the pit.
